**New College Access Accommodation Scholarship**

Open to incoming residents only. New College offers a residential scholarship based on financial and other hardship. Each New College Access Accommodation Scholarship is subject to an annual review and typically only runs for two years.

*Criteria:* Financial hardship, with other hardship also considered.

*Value:* \$6000

**The Founders Bursary**

Open to incoming residents only. In 2002 the Board of New College instituted a Bursary to honour the founders of the College. Each Founder's Bursary typically continues for up to two years, subject to annual review. Recipients are expected to maintain a distinction average.

*Criteria:* Academic performance and financial hardship.

*Value:* \$6000

**Alumni Scholarship**

Open to new and returning students. The value of this scholarship may vary depending on available funds. It is a non-continuing scholarship, and all applicants are considered on merit each year.

*Criteria:* Demonstration of financial need, academic merit, leadership qualities and community participation, and potential to contribute to community life at New College.

*Value:* \$4000.

**Jared Pritchard Memorial Scholarship**

Open to new and returning students. The Jared Pritchard Memorial Scholarship is awarded on an annual basis to a New Collegian in recognition of their ability to contribute to the creative and performing arts.

*Criteria:* Involvement in the creative and performing arts (please provide supporting evidence for this). Academic ability and financial hardship may also be considered.

*Value:* \$2500.

**Bible Society Young Scholars**

The purpose of the Bible Society Young Scholars program is to promote Christian scholarship amongst those living at New College and NCV while they study at UNSW, Australia. Each scholarship is for an initial period of 1 year. Scholarship may be extended subject to performance and available funding. Application for this scholarship must be accompanied by a letter addressing the specific criteria at <http://www.newcollege.unsw.edu.au/sydney/bible-society-young-scholars>

*Value:* \$2000.

**Bursary Assistance**

A limited amount of Bursary assistance is also available. The number of Bursaries varies depending on the need each year, but the value of financial assistance typically ranges from \$500-\$3000 per bursary recipient per year.

*Criteria:* The assistance is offered to continuing and incoming residents and is primarily based on financial needs, with academic merit and other special needs also being considered.

*Value:* Typically \$500 - \$3000.

Note that except where stated otherwise, recipients of continuing scholarships are expected to maintain at least a credit average.
